

No individual show required in ANY class. The judge will not ride in any class. Please be ready in the warm-up ring at least one class before you are due to show, to assist the Gate Steward. In hand horses to trot to end of first rail and line up nose to tail. You will then be pulled forward for individual inspection.

ALL ENTRIES to enter at TROT (or equivalent, e.g. jog/corto), including in hand, except Walk/Trot classes - enter at walk. **No individual ridden show required.** The judge will not ride in any class. Allow 10-15 minutes per class – please arrive earlier rather than later so as not to miss your class.

Exhibitors may wear approved safety hats (& jackets) in any class without penalty. All junior exhibitors (under 18) MUST wear an approved safety hat in all classes, including in hand. Riders are advised to wear a secured safety hat (to current safety standards) at all times when mounted. Should ADULT riders wish to wear traditional non-safety headgear they must sign to indicate they are aware of our safety policy and choose not to follow it (see entry form). This will be entirely at their own risk and the Organisers will not be responsible in any way for any incident that arises from such actions.

Stables (& hook-ups) are available on site & can be booked directly with OGE (01788-817724) and will be accepted on a first come/first served basis. There are a limited number of permanent stables available on a nightly basis. Temporary stabling is also available if there is sufficient demand.

This event has been organised for the Foreign Breed Society (UK) [FBS] by a selected committee. QUALIFICATION IS REQUIRED FOR ALL FINAL CLASSES, which will be preceded by "FINAL" in the schedule - only one card per horse is necessary to qualify, not one card per class. Exhibitors must also be FBS members to take part in the Final classes (memberships can be taken on the day). Once qualified horses/ponies may enter any suitable classes. Qualification can also be gained at today's show in the late qualifying classes – top 10 in all classes qualify and can enter any suitable championship class, at the pre-entry price.

ALL RIDDEN CLASSES MAY BE RESTRICTED IN NUMBERS or GO-ROUNDS held.

Please enter as soon as possible to ensure your place in the class of choice.

PUREBREDS – must be registered with the appropriate breed society
(copy of papers to be submitted with entries).

PARTBRED / UNREGISTERED – open to partbreds and unregistered "purebreds".

UNLESS stated otherwise, all ridden classes are open to both Pure and Part/Unregistered.

LATE QUALIFIERS: 8.30am sharp: ADVANCE ENTRIES ONLY FOR LATE QUALIFIERS.

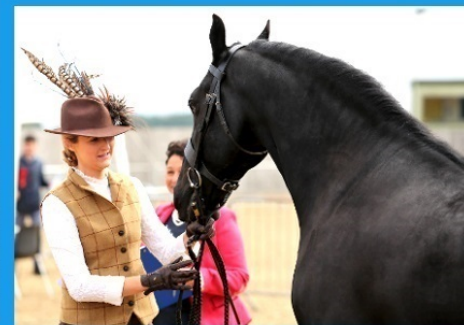
