



FOREIGN BREEDS SOCIETY MEMBERSHIP APPLICATION FORM 2018: expires 31st December 2018.

DEFINITION: Foreign Breeds: any horse that is non-indigenous to the British Isle, excludes Irish horses/ponies.

FOREIGN BREEDS SOCIETY: Is a not for profit organisation to act as an umbrella showing society for all Foreign Breeds in the UK.

MEMBERSHIP runs each year until 31st December: 1st Jan to 31st December.

RULES

- Membership is open to anyone interested in promoting Foreign Breeds and is not restricted to UK-based residents. However, membership is a privilege and not a right and can be suspended revoked if the aims or interest of the Society is brought into disrepute.
- Membership Fees: £15 adult, £10 Junior (under 18), runs 1st January to 31st December (UK based prices, for overseas members, add 50%).
- Members are able to enter the Championship Show at a greatly reduced price.
- All members will also receive an annual publication from the Foreign Breeds Society.
