



# FOREIGN BREEDS SOCIETY SHOW AFFILIATION INSTRUCTIONS

**DEFINITION:** Foreign Breeds: any horse that is non-indigenous to the British Isle, excludes Irish horses/ponies. **FOREIGN BREEDS SOCIETY:** Is a not for profit organisation to act as an umbrella showing society for all Foreign Breeds in the UK.

## AFFILIATION RULES

### **BASIC AFFILIATION - FREE**

- You must have at least 3 Foreign Breed classes, or breed specific classes (e.g. Lusitano), or 2 classes and a championship to be eligible to be a FBS affiliated show. Show details will be included on our website, on our Facebook Group and within our printed annual. Show results (& photos) can also be included in our annual if space permits.
- The top 3 in each class qualify – qualification status may be passed down the line if horses have already qualified.
- The onus is on competitors to download their qualification card (from our website) prior to taking part at your event and to get the cards signed on the day of the event if they qualify. There are NO cards for the show organiser to hand out.
- Shows held up to and including 31<sup>st</sup> July 2017 are qualifiers for our 2017 Championship Show and shows held on or after 1<sup>st</sup> August 2017 (to 31<sup>st</sup> July 2018) are qualifiers for our 2018 Championship Show.
- NO lengthy wording is needed for your schedule - all you need to do is say "This class (or classes X to Y) is/are a qualifier for the 2017/2018 FBS Championship Show and will be judged under FBS American (or English, as appropriate) Rules - details from: [www.foreignbreeds.org](http://www.foreignbreeds.org)
- Please see our website for the "Showing Foreign Breeds" page for the definition of the American and English showing rules. The American rules have NO individual show (& the judge does not ride) and so classes take approx. 15 minutes – this is a popular choice for many shows as it means more classes can be included.
- Any Panel Judge is acceptable, although we do recommend selection from our extensive FBS Judges List. Please ensure that your judges are familiar with the Rules – these can be obtained from our website.
- List of winners will be included in the FBS annual (to be submitted by the show paper version or by email to: [show@foreignbreeds.org](mailto:show@foreignbreeds.org), copy deadline 1<sup>st</sup> November).
- **AFFILIATION FEE:** FREE! Simply complete and return this form (by email or post) and your show details will go on our website and in our annual.

### **FULL AFFILIATION - £10**

- All of the above PLUS
- Show write up and colour photo will be included in the FBS annual (to be submitted by the show, copy deadline 1<sup>st</sup> November, photos to be sent with copyright approval from photographers). List of winners to be included if space permits.
- PDF of show schedule on our FBS website.
- Set of FBS Champion & Reserve rosettes provided for presentation at your show.
